

## VISITING WITH YOUR DOG

Dogs are very welcome at the Yorkshire Arboretum. To ensure you and your dog enjoy your visit, and other arboretum users enjoy theirs, please follow this code:

- Please put your dog on a lead as soon as you arrive in the car park as this can be a dangerous place for your pet. Also, dogs in vehicles can be upset by loose dogs.
- Please keep your dog on a lead in the designated areas. These areas are home to sensitive wildlife or are where our children's activities take place.
- Please keep your dog under your close control if you let it off the lead in permitted areas. If you don't trust your dog to come back when called please don't let it off the lead.
- Please put your dog on a lead straight away if requested to do so for any reason by a member of staff or another visitor anywhere in the arboretum.
- Please don't allow your dog to approach other people or dogs unless invited. Other visitors may dislike, or be scared of, dogs and some dogs may be aggressive if approached.
- Please clear up after your pet. Waste bins are located around the arboretum or please take your rubbish home.
- Well-behaved dogs on leads are welcome on the café terrace. Water bowls are available, which can be refilled at the tap on the front wall of the building.
- Please keep your dog to the carpeted area of the Visitor Centre. Dogs are not allowed elsewhere in the building.
